PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead cross functional teams in CI projects.
- Train and coach employees in Continuous Improvement (CI) techniques.
- Help to identify improvement projects.
- Coach employees as they progress CI projects.
- Coach and consult on the use of Lean tools and promotes Lean principles.
- Lead and support the adoption of Lean tools such as 6S, Visual management, Waste elimination, Morning meetings, Kaizen boards.

- Coach managers / supervisors in Lean Leadership so that they can teach their own staff.
